President's Report:

- PHRF Championship Regatta Debrief
 - o 22 boats entered
 - o 42 boats 2014 vs. 22 boats 2015
 - Some reasons:
 - Transpac year
 - Farr 40 event at same time
 - "Too much wind" concern from a number of competitors
 - For those in attendance a good regatta with great yacht club, good food, Mt. Gay hats and rum, etc.
 - Initial Conclusions: Spending too much money and effort for the limited level of competitor participation
 - Discussed at August meeting
 - In August, a Motion passed to discontinue PHRF SoCal Championships for 2016 and to re-invent the regatta for 2017
 - However, upon discussion with Bruce Cooper of Ullman, as primary sponsor, further discussion at September Board Meeting was agreed to before any final decision about 2016 PHRF SoCal Championship Regatta
 - Bruce Cooper was invited to speak at September Meeting before the Regional Board
 - Bruce Cooper's comments:
 - PHRF is the easiest and most equitable form of sailboat racing
 - If planning the same type of regatta next year, we should not hold event because a predictable low number of entries a new "model" is needed
 - LBRW is facing the same issues getting boats
 - Ideas: run a successful "championship" regatta
 - Each Area recognizes outstanding boats with podium finishes, should be invited
 - Top winners or those that qualified
 - Set guidelines such as 5 races, combining buoy races to feeder races such as Santa Barbara/King Harbor, etc.
 - Vice President to reserve a yacht club and date for 2016

- Need to submit to SCYA
- Maybe schedule October/November so it is the end of year's Championships
- Motion to withdraw previous cancellation of 2016 Championship Regatta, reevaluate, set a date, set new format at a later date/S/P
- Technology Initiative
 - Need to increase opportunities to involve members and boards (both Regional and Areas) by virtual meeting participation
 - Need to make PHRF SoCal administration more efficient through use of technology
 - Rick von Heydenreich will present an initial proposal next month

- Open rating review request was read into record:
 - For the last couple of years it has been almost impossible for us to correct over Horizon especially in OWC. This has caused me to look carefully at both the PHRF and ORR certificates to try and understand the change.
 - I have noticed that when they replaced the mast 4/12, they did so with a taller mast, and it does not appear the ratings reflected this change.
 - Please note the major differences affecting sail area:
 - HORIZON
 FLACA
 I: 61.8
 E: 19
 17
 - ISP: 62.7 61
 - SPL: 20,3 19.08

• Based on these dimensions our actual sail areas OWC are dramatically different:

- SailHorizonFlacaDiff.Main52446757+12%46757
- ASYM 1980 1780 200 +11%
- I'm sure you can see that these differences are significant especially in any course where the down wind legs are dominant.
- Besides I would like to point out that comparing the ORR ratings for both of us, it works out that Horizon gives us 11 to 12 sec per mile in such races as Cabo, Vallarta as well as Ensenada....yet on PHRF we are forced to compete at only a 6 sec. differential.
- If we had been competing on a more level field, we would have corrected over Horizon in two of our previous races, the most recent, Long Point to Newport where we both had a great races yet they still bet us by 80 sec corrected.
- I enjoy racing and like everyone I enjoy placing, yet it's hard to get enthusiastic when competing against boats that no matter what we do, it is almost impossible to beat.
- Horizon is a well sailed boat, one that consistently does well, so far the only way to beat them is if they make a big mistake--doesn't happen very often.
