 - 2/21/18 Reviewed base rating and compared to original application
 - 2/21/18 1ST READING MOTION/-81/-84/-93/ [DELTA OF (+12) (+12) (+6)] FROM 97777 AS BASE RATING S/P 1-OPPOSED
 - 4/18/18 Witnesses in Opposition: Robbie Heinz and Robert Plant
