    - How long should an adjustment be valid for?
    - Do we need any additional data collected for future use in this area?
  - What additional data might we want to collect from our members (via renew and new member forms) to better prepare us for interactions with the ORR-EZ, if any?

- Owner was very polite but confused regarding the inconsistency
- Area adjustments should be considered during the Reading (1<sup>st</sup>/2<sup>nd</sup>) as Area adjustments "go away" if not dealt with during Review
  - Area C must schedule a review for the Temporary Rating that Chief Handicapper issued after the meeting
    - Example
      - Previously rated /114/114/114 with (-3) Area C adjustment /111/111/111/
      - Approved rating /112/112/112/
        - If no Area C adjustment there would have been a (+1) second advantage
        - Current Temporary Area rating /109/109/109
          - To be scheduled and review by Area C Board
  - Judge Advocated to review Rules and report back to Regional Board
- o Preparation for Rating Reviews
  - Policy in place for Owner Requested rating reviews
    - Must submit properly completed Request AND race results
      - Once scheduled, owner should update, if any races to report
  - No set time line has been adjusted
    - Currently, Fleet Secretary must give notice of boats for review 7 days prior
    - Currently asking for results by Friday prior but not able to enforce
    - Suggestion, but would cause a little more work for Chief Handicapper:
      - o List of boats to be review in upcoming meeting, and
      - A 2<sup>nd</sup> List for the next month to give extra notice with a more reasonable cut off.
  - Fleet Secretary to draft letter to all Temporary Rating holders outlining the requirements:
    - Making temp rating finalized
    - What they are responsible for
    - Outline opposition period and options available
  - Data Systems Manager to post all Temporary Ratings
    - Fleet Secretary to send list to Data Systems
- Expenditures not previously authorized by Regional Board
  - Must send a copy of the invoice to Fleet Secretary
  - Should there be to set an amount for Fleet Secretary to cut a check without Treasurer's authorization? Over a certain amount?
    - In past have reimbursed Data Manager for previously approved expenditures for database and such (approved at meeting then yearly renewals, as an example)

          - Difficult to make ORA database to work for others not familiar with the software
          - Would need a fairly sophisticated person to manage the database
          - Taken back by the software
          - Impressed but should be viewed as another tool for review
          - In May 2021, submitted information, application, money and actual drawings but have not received any type of reply
        - S Griesbach
          - Software would be difficult to use effectively
          - ORA is looking for our business but still have a great deal of development work to complete
          - Not clear if they can handle the 50+ PHRF boats not yet in its system
      - No longer considering ORA partnership this year

- Next year start with cruising boats and high tech modified
- Turn around is very slow even with expert assistance to get applications processed with help
- Configuration Recap by B Langan
  - It appears those that should have Configuration Adjustment appear to be correctly awarded
