Attention to all SCYA affiliated Yacht Clubs and Racing Authorities/Organizers:

Pursuant to PHRF SoCal governing Rules, please note that when the Regional Board reviews and rates a boat, the Regional Board shall be guided by Rule 2.2 which states:

- "2.2 To more accurately reflect the speed potential of boats on different points of sail, PHRF uses a system of THREE RATINGS. The Ratings are designated as the "WINDWARD/LEEWARD COURSE RATING" (W/L), the "RANDOM LEG COURSE RATING" (RLC), and the "OFFWIND COURSE RATING" (OWC), each of which is defined below.
- a. W/L Ratings are intended to be used when the course is expected to be primarily windward/leeward legs on courses set in relation to the wind.
- b. RLC Ratings are intended to be used when the course type is neither W/L nor OWC.
- c. OWC Ratings are intended to be used when at least 2/3 of the course distance is expected to be more than 135 degrees from true wind direction."

As a rating organization, PHRF SoCal is governed by its Rules. However, Racing Authorities/Organizers run their own events. Therefore, PHRF SoCal respectfully requests that in fairness, all Racing Authorities/Organizers consider the rules when deciding which of the three (3) ratings to accept for their races.

However, if the race or series courses are identified as any of the courses described in Rule 2.2, but the conditions are such that they become inconsistent with the course identified in the Race Documents, the Racing Authorities/Organizers can allow for a change by including the following language in their Race Documents:

"The Race Committee, in its sole discretion, without leave for protest, may score the race or series employing the PHRF ratings consistent with those identified in PHRF SoCal's Rule 2.2, and the conditions actually experienced on the Race Course."

As an example, if a race or series is noted as employing the W/L ratings described in PHRF SoCal's Rule 2.2, but on the day of the race, the conditions dictate OWC ratings as more appropriate, with the language above or similar, the race may be properly scored.
